FACILITY CLOSURE AND TEMPORARY RELOCATION OF JUVENILE JUSTICE COURT HEARINGS

The Superior Court of California, County of Butte is providing public notice, pursuant to Government Code § 68106, of forthcoming change to facility access.

The Butte County Juvenile Hall Courtroom located at 51 County Center Drive, Oroville, CA 95965 will be temporarily closed beginning Monday, June 1, 2026, and until further notice to allow for construction to commence on a planned addition and renovation. The project will build on the Court's ongoing commitment to access to justice by enhancing the functionality of the facility.

During this temporary closure, all juvenile justice court hearings will be conducted in a courtroom at the Butte County Courthouse located at One Court Street, Oroville, CA 95965. Updated hearing location and time information will be provided directly to affected parties through mailed notices. Confidentiality requirements governing juvenile proceedings will remain fully in effect throughout this temporary relocation.
