The Amended Petition needs also to include information regarding bond in paragraphs 2.d. and 3.e., which are incomplete in the Petition presently before the Court. As to Objector Thomas Lynn Plymesser's "Petition to Remove Executor; Request for Suspension of Powers; Request for Accounting; Objection to Probate and/or Appointment of Executor", the Court notes that removal is premature as there has been no appointment by the Court. The Court thus deems the Petition an Objection to the appointment and a contest of the Will (as there are allegations as to the validity of "any instrument advanced by Teri"). The Court further notes that to the extent the Objector seeks a ruling in relation to any Trust document, that issue is not properly before the Court in this Estate matter, and any relief in regard thereto is denied.
