7. <u>25CV02313 California Highway Patrol v. McNeil, Gregory C</u>

EVENT: Vehicle Forfeiture Petition

The Court will hear from Petitioner.

Preliminarily, it appears that California Highway Patrol has attempted to pursue this Petition in a self-represented capacity. The caption of the Petition simply provides the CHP Valley division address. There is no indication that a licensed member of the bar filed this Petition on CHP's behalf.

The principle that a corporation may not be represented by a non-lawyer stems from case law, see *Merco Constr. Engineers, Inc. v. Municipal Court* (1978) 21 Cal.3d 724. The rationale is that a non-lawyer representing an entity essentially amounts to the unauthorized practice of law. The same reasoning prohibits a non-lawyer from representing a governmental entity. In other words, a government entity must be represented by counsel in a judicial proceeding.

Additionally, there is no proof of service indicating claimants and the individual from whom the vehicle was seized were provided notice of this hearing. After reviewing Officer Craven's declaration, it is clear that, at a minimum, George C. McNeil, Miguel Medrano, Capital Ford, Manheim Auto Auction, and Israel Chavez are entitled to notice of this hearing pursuant to VC § 10751(c).

Accordingly, the Petition will need to be continued for Petitioner to obtain counsel, and to cure the notice issues identified in this ruling.
