1. <u>18CV03568</u> <u>D&E GIORDANO REVOCABLE FAMILY TRUST DATED JUNE 2, 2010</u> <u>ET AL V. KUNTHSON-LOOMIS, MERLE</u>

EVENT: Motion for Leave to Amend Answer to Cross-Complaint to Allege Additional Affirmative Defenses and to File a Cross-Complaint

There is no proof of service in the Court's file and as such, notice does not comply with Code of Civil Procedure §1005. However, even if the Court were to consider the Motion in light of the failure to provide proper notice, the Court notes that there are numerous procedural errors that would require denial, including failure to include a copy of the proposed amended pleading, failure to set forth the allegations proposed to be changed with the required specificity, and failure to provide a declaration that sufficiently states the effect of the amendment, why the amendment is necessary and proper, when the facts giving rise to the amended allegations were discovered, and the reasons the request for amendment was not made earlier.
